or the second time in four years, Nikki Pfeiffer was invited to the Fox21 station to receive, live on air, a check for winning the 3-Degree Guarantee contest!

Every day during FOX21 Morning News, the FOX21 Storm Team shows you how accurate their Colorado Springs forecast was from the day before. If they get the forecast correct within 3 degrees (plus or minus), WireNut Home Services donates \$30 to a charity fund, and FOX21 matches that donation. At the end of the month, the money in the fund is then donated to a local charity of the viewer's choosing. This program has been been in effect for six years, and as of July 2nd, 2025, The Multiple Sclerosis Alliance of Southern Colorado became the first local charity to be chosen by viewers twice!

"This is an true honor," said Nikki Pfeiffer, Executive Director of the MSA said.

Each month the winner of the 3 Degree Guarantee program is chosen based on the number of nominations that charity received the prior month. As long as you keep nominating, we can keep winning! Click here to nominate us again!

The winning charity is chosen each month according to the number of nominations received on the station's website the month prior. In November of 2021, The MSA won a total of \$1,800. In June, the Storm Team had a little more trouble with their accuracy, but the pot still grew to \$1,620.

"That's so cool about what we do here," said Trent Urban, CEO of The WireNut and funder of this program, "Funds don't go through a wasteful funnel. It all goes directly to those who need it."
